No: TD 250 TDO 2019, Bengaluru, dated: 21-09-2019

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 200 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Central Act 59 of 1988) read with Section 21 of the General Clauses Act, 1897 and in supersession of the earlier Notification No:TD 250 TDO 2019 dated:03-09-2019, the Government of Karnataka hereby authorize the following officers to levy the penalties specified in column (4) of the table below in respect of offences specified in column (2) and (3) thereof as follows;

- (1) All officers of and above the rank of Motor Vehicles Inspectors of the Transport Department.
- (2) Officers of and above the rank of Assistant Sub-Inspector of Police (Traffic), Sub-Inspector of Police (in charge of Police Station) of the Police Department within the respective jurisdiction **except Sections 113, 114, 115 r/w Section 194; Section 182, Section 62A r/w Section 182B; 182A(1), 182A(3), 182A(4), 190, 192, 192A, 194 & 194A.**

This Notification comes into force with effect from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
